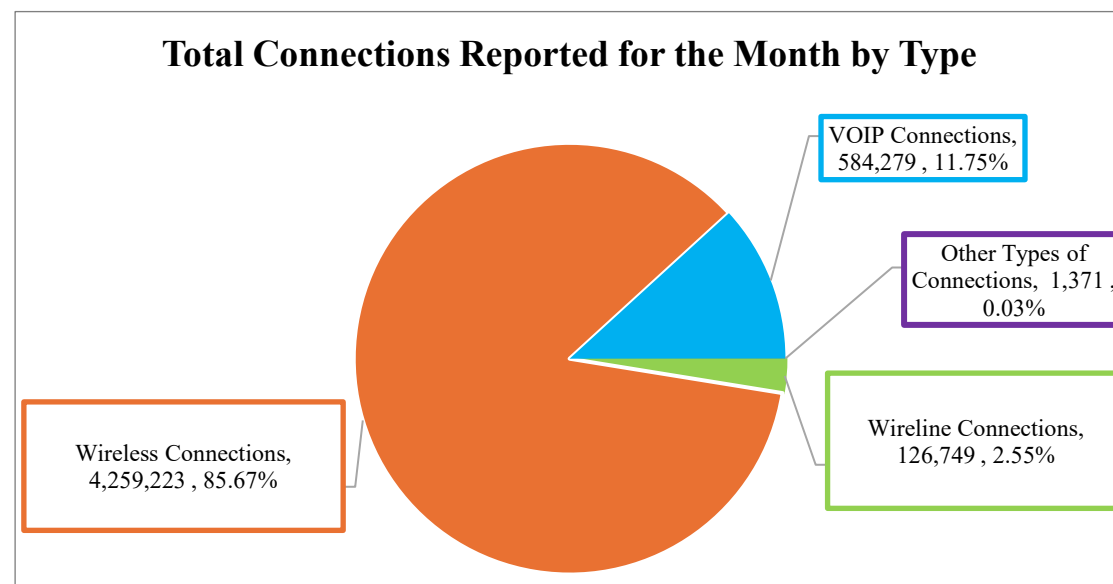
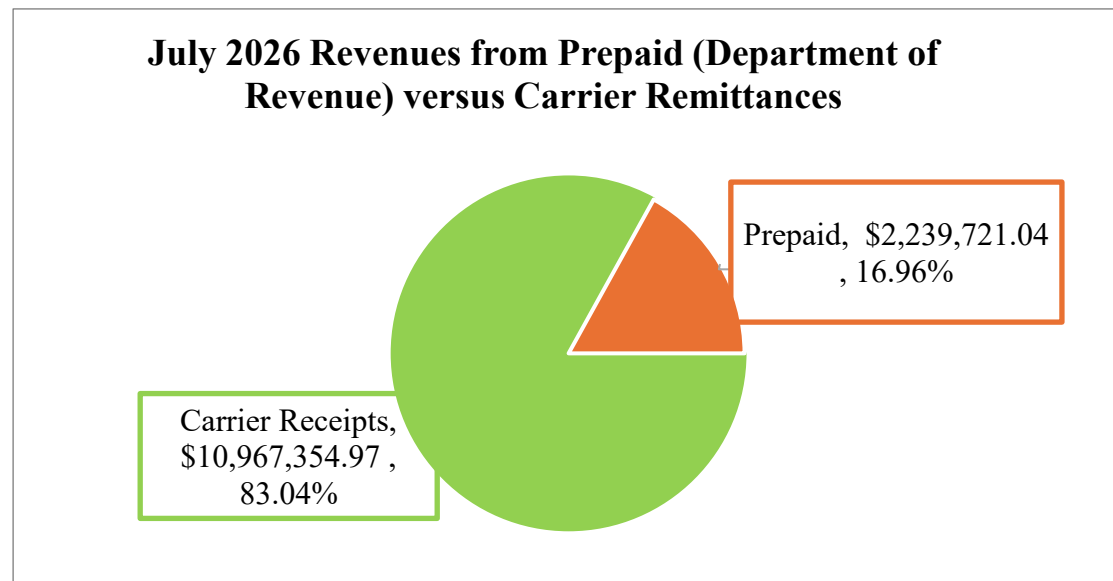

Dear ECD Director,

The information below represents the 9-1-1 Fund as a whole for collection of the service charge levied on voice communications service providers and all prepaid wireless 911 charges received from the Department of Revenue in the month of July 2026 scheduled for distribution in the month of August 2026. Your District's portion of these funds will be made available in your account on the dates indicated below. The full monthly distribution calculation can be found on the following pages.

During the previous month, 429 carrier submissions reported 4,971,622 connections remitted through the Board's payment engine and the other revenues were collected by the Department of Revenue and paid over to the Board. The breakdown is as follows:

Beginning October 1, 2025, with the effective date of Act 2025-376, monthly baseline distributions will be made on or about the 15th of each month. Population distributions will be made on or about the 20th of each month. Reimbursements will continue to be made on or about the last business day of each month. Any other distributions made by the Board will be on a date of the Board's choosing and availability of funds.
